Once we have received God's Word, God's influence in our lives, we must understand that demon spirits will try to steal it from us. However, when we understand spiritual warfare, we will keep what God has given to us.

Key points:

- Saved = to be healed, to be made whole, to have prosperity, to have deliverance, to have safety, and to be preserved. It's a package deal.
- Keep = possess in your mind.
- Keeping God's Word in our mind hinders the anti-Christ from making his appearance.
- Memorize Scriptures that relate to our situation or need.

Scriptures:

- 1 Corinthians 15:2 – saved if you keep in memory the Word of God
- 1 Corinthians 9:27 – the Apostle Paul had to bring his body into subjection
- John 10:10 – the thief (satan) comes to steal, kill, and destroy
- Isaiah 53:4-5; 1 Peter 2:24 – by His stripes we are healed
- Matthew 7:7; Luke 11:9 – seek and you will find
- 1 Timothy 6:12 – fight the good fight of faith
- John 8:32 – Jesus said you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free
- Luke 11:24-26; Matthew 12:43-45 – demons return after they are cast out
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 – take every thought captive
- James 2:20 – actions activate God's power
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 – our weapons are mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds
- Ephesians 6:12 – we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, powers
- Matthew 24:35 – heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will never pass away
- 3 John 2 – God's will is for us to be in health and prosper even as our soul prospers
- Mark 4:15 – satan comes immediately to steal the Word
- Mark 4:13 – know this parable, and we'll know all parables
- Hebrews 3:14 – we are partakers of Christ if we hold our confidence steadfast
- 1 Corinthians 12:27 – we are the body of Christ
- Revelation 3:11 – hold fast so that no man takes our crown
- James 1:12 – receive the crown of life
- Revelation 1:6; Revelation 19:16 – we are kings, and He is the King of Kings
- Hebrews 4:12 – the Word of God is sharper than any two-edged sword
