Key points:

- Scripture clearly teaches we are at war with the devil and his demons.
- The weapons of our warfare are mighty through God to the pulling down of every strong hold.
- God is only good. So if it's not good, there's a demon there.
- Jesus gave us His name, which is above every name, so we can have victory.

Scriptures:

- Ephesians 3:3-4 – the mystery is made known when we read the Word
- Ephesians 3:10 – principalities and powers are made known unto the Church
- Ephesians 6:10-17 – we are strong in the Lord and have the armor of God
- 2 Corinthians 10:4-5 – the weapons of our warfare are mighty through God
- Matthew 12:30; Mark 9:40; Luke 11:23 – Jesus said who is not for Me is against Me
- John 10:10 – the thief (satan) comes to steal, kill, and destroy, but Jesus came to give life
- Nehemiah 8:10 – the joy of the Lord is our strength
- Philippians 2:9 – the name of Jesus is above every name
- John 1:1 ; Revelation 11:13 – His name is the Word of God
- Proverbs 15:1 – a soft answer turns away wrath
- Malachi 3:8-11 – the devourer is rebuked when we tithe
- Luke 6:38 – give and it's given unto us good measure, pressed together, running over
- James 1:17 – every good gift/perfect gift is from God
- Matthew 7:11; Luke 11:13 – natural men give good gifts to their children, but God does even better
- 1 Corinthians 2:14 – natural man doesn't receive the things of God; they are spiritually discerned
- Romans 8:1-2 – there are only 2 choices: it's of God or of the devil
- Song of Solomon 2:15 – it's the little foxes that spoil the vine
- Romans 8:6-7 – to be carnally minded is death; the carnal mind is enmity against God
- Matthew 12:43-45; Luke 11:24-26 – demons return after they are cast out
- Romans 6:23 – the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life
- 1 Peter 3:10 – we can love life and see good days by keeping our tongue from evil
- Matthew 5:37 – let our yes be yes and our no be no
- Proverbs 29:1 – whoever is reprov'd but hardens their neck will suddenly be destroyed
- Lamentations 3:22-23 – God's mercy and compassion fail not; great is His faithfulness
- 1 Corinthians 9:27 – bring our bodies under subjections
- Matthew 18:8-9 – don't tolerate sin in your life
- James 1:15 – when sin is finished, it brings forth death
- 1 Corinthians 11:31 – we judge ourselves
- 2 Corinthians 5:21 – we are the righteousness of God in Christ
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 – we are a new creation in Christ
