Everyone wants promotions in their lives. God wants us to have daily promotions. God's daily promotions seem small, but He watches to see if we are faithful with the small promotions before He gives us large promotions. Jesus said if we are not faithful in little we will not be faithful in much. God loves us too much to promote us with great things that would destroy us, because we are not ready for them.

Key points:

- Use what you have – we already have what we need to get started.
- Sometimes God is waiting for us to be faithful where we are and with what we have before He can promote us.
- The Holy Spirit will lead you to a Red Sea moment. Use what you already have because little is much in God's hands.
- If you're faithful in the little things, you'll be faithful in the big things.
- Words are powerful! Every word is a chance for a promotion. Avoid idle, useless words; instead, speak words of life and blessing in every situation.
- Thoughts are words in the spirit realm, so think on good things.

Scriptures:

- Luke 16:10-11 – “He that is faithful in that which is least is faithful also in much: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much. If therefore ye have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches?”
- Exodus 14:15-16 – “And the Lord said unto Moses, wherefore criest thou unto me? Speak unto the children of Israel, that they go forward: but lift thou up thy rod, and stretch out thine hand over the sea, and divide it: and the children of Israel shall go on dry ground through the midst of the sea.”
- Malachi 3:10-11 – “Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the Lord of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it. And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the Lord of hosts.”
- Matthew 12:37 – “For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.”
- Proverbs 18:21 – “Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.”
- Hebrews 11:3 – “Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.”
- Psalm 19:14 – “Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer.”
- Matthew 12:36 – “But I say unto you, that every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.”
