

Scripture Verses to Claim Your Healing!

If you believe that every Word in the Bible is true and inspired by God, these verses from the King James Version Bible and the King James Truth Version Bible will guide you in receiving your healing.

When speaking or meditating on these Scripture verses, I encourage you to personalize each verse. For example, Isaiah 53:5 could read like this: "Jesus was wounded for *my* transgressions, he was bruised for *my* iniquities; the chastisement of *my* peace was upon Him; and with His stripes *I* am healed!" As you speak it over and over, you will believe and see it more and more.

Here are scripture verses from the Old and New Testaments for healing and encouragement:

OLD TESTAMENT

Exodus 23:25-26 – I will serve the LORD my God, and His blessing will be on my food and water. He will take away my sickness.

Deuteronomy 3:22 – I do not fear for the Lord my God fights for me.

Deuteronomy 7:15 - The LORD will take away from me all sickness and will allow none of the terrible diseases to be on me.

Deuteronomy 28:1-2,7 - If I diligently obey the voice of the Lord my God, to observe carefully and do all His commandments, that God will set me high above all nations of the earth. And all His blessings will come upon me and overtake me, because I obey the voice of the Lord my God. The Lord will cause my enemies [sickness and disease] who rise against me to be defeated before my face and they will flee.

Joshua 1:7-8 – I am strong and very courageous. I am careful to obey all of God's laws. I do not depart from God's laws, so that I may prosper wherever I go. God's laws will not withdraw from my mouth, but I will meditate on it day and night so I can observe to do all that is written in it. Then will I prosper and have success in all I do.

Psalms 1:1-3 – Blessed is the man who does not walk or agree with the ungodly, nor stands with sinners, nor sits with the scornful. But my delight is in the law of the Lord, and I meditate on His law during the day and night. I shall be like a tree

planted by the rivers of water bringing forth my fruit in due season. I will not wither (fall away, faint, be foolish or wicked) and whatever I do shall prosper.

Psalm 6:2 - Have mercy on me, LORD, for I am weak. Heal me, LORD, for my bones are vexed (alarmed, agitated, anxious, afraid, troubled).

Psalm 23:1-6 - The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want (lack anything). He makes me lie down in green pastures; he leads me beside the still waters. He restores my soul: He leads me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil (adversity, affliction, distress, trouble) for He is with me; His rod and staff comfort me. He prepares a table before me in the presence of my enemies; He anoints my head with oil; my cup runs over. Surely goodness and mercy will follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

Psalm 27:1 – The Lord is my light and my salvation (deliverance, liberty, safety, healing); who shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? [I will fear no evil for the Lord is with me always.]

Psalm 30:2 - LORD my God, I called to you for help, and you healed me!

Psalm 34:17-18 - The righteous cry out, and the LORD hears them. He delivers them from all their troubles. The LORD is close to the brokenhearted and He saves those who are crushed in spirit.

Psalm 41:3 – The Lord strengthens me when I'm sick or sorrowful. He overturns my sickness, disease, grief, and anxiety.

Psalm 52:1 – The goodness of God endures continually.

Psalm 73:26 - My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion (inheritance) forever.

Psalm 84:11 – The Lord God is a sun and shield, and He gives grace and glory. No good thing will the Lord God withhold from me because I walk uprightly (in integrity, truth, sincerely, undefiled, whole).

Psalm 86:15 – But You, O Lord, are a God full of compassion. You are gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in mercy and truth.

Psalm 91:2-3 – The Lord is my refuge (shelter) and my fortress (strong place). I put all my trust in Him! He will deliver me from the snare of the fowler and from the noisome (wicked) pestilence (plague, sickness).

Psalm 91:9-10, 16 – Because I have made the Lord my God my refuge and my dwelling place, no evil (sickness or disease) shall befall me, nor shall any plague

come near my dwelling. With long life God will satisfy me and show me His salvation (deliverance, prosperity, healing, welfare).

Psalm 92:14 – Even in my old age I will still produce fruit (flourish, make cheerful, increase), be fat (rich, fertile) and flourish (prosper).

Psalm 103:2-4 – I praise the LORD with all my heart and forget not all He has done for me. He forgives all my sins and heals all my diseases. He redeems my life from the pit of destruction and crowns me with His lovingkindness and tender mercies.

Psalm 103:20 – Bless the Lord, and His angels, who excel in strength, who do His works heeding the voice of His Word (His promises).

Psalm 105:37 - There was not one feeble person among His people [and I am His child].

Psalm 107:20 – God sent His word and healed me and delivered me from destruction.

Psalm 118:17 – I shall not die, but I will live and declare the works of the Lord!

Psalm 119:50 - This is my comfort in my affliction (depression, misery, trouble), that your Word [promises] gives me life.

Psalms 127:3 – Children are a heritage (inheritance) from the LORD, and the fruit of the womb is His reward.

Psalm 147:3 - God heals my broken heart and binds up my wounds (pains, sorrows).

Proverbs 3:5-8 – I trust in the Lord with all my heart and lean not on my own understanding. In all my ways, I acknowledge (know, consider, respect) Him, and He will direct my path. I am not wise in my own eyes. I fear the Lord and depart from evil. This will bring health and refreshment to my body.

Proverbs 4:20-22 – As a child of God, I pay attention to His words. I incline my ear to what He says. I do not let His Word depart from my eyes; I keep them in the midst of my heart. For God's Words are life to those who find them, and health (medicine) to all their flesh.

Proverbs 6:2 – The devil tries to snare me by the words of my mouth, [but I have put a guard on my mouth to agree with what God says.]

Proverbs 16:24 - Pleasant words are like a honeycomb, sweet to the soul and healing to the bones.

Proverbs 17:22 - A joyful heart is good medicine, but a broken spirit dries up the bones. [I will focus on speaking healthy, positive words so I will have a joyful life.]

Ecclesiastes 3:1-8 - There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens. There is a time to be born and a time to die, a time to plant and a time to uproot, a time to kill and a time to heal, a time to tear down and a time to build, a time to weep and a time to laugh, a time to mourn and a time to dance, a time to scatter stones and a time to gather them, a time to embrace and a time to refrain from embracing, a time to search and a time to give up, a time to keep and a time to throw away, a time to tear and a time to mend, a time to be silent and a time to speak, a time to love and a time to hate, a time for war and a time for peace.

Isaiah 26:3 – You will keep me in perfect peace (health, happy, prosperity, and safety), because my mind is stayed (established, sustained) on You and I trust You.

Isaiah 33:2 - LORD, be gracious to me. I have waited for you. Be my strength every morning, and my salvation (deliverance, health, welfare) in time of trouble.

Isaiah 38:16-17 – Lord, by these things men live, and in all these things is the life of my spirit: will you recover me and make me to live. Behold, for peace I had great bitterness: but You have in love delivered my soul from the pit of corruption (destruction). You have cast all my sins behind Your back [to remember them no more].

Isaiah 40:29, 31 - You give power to the faint (exhausted, weary), and to those who have no might (strength or ability) You increase their strength. Those who wait on the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

Isaiah 41:10 – I will not fear because God is with me. I will not be dismayed, for He is my God. He will strengthen me; yes, He will help me. He will uphold (help) me with His righteous right hand.

Isaiah 41:13 – For the Lord my God holds my right hand and says to me, “Fear not, I will help you!”

Isaiah 53:4-5 – God bore my griefs and carried my sorrows. He was wounded for my wrongdoings; he was bruised for my sins. The punishment for me to have peace was upon Him, and by His stripes I AM HEALED!

Isaiah 54:17 – No weapon [sickness is a weapon of the enemy] formed against me shall prosper! Every tongue that rises against me in judgment I will condemn. This is my heritage (inheritance) as a servant of the Lord and is from the Lord.

Isaiah 55:10-12 – For as the rain and snow come down from heaven and do not return there, but water the earth and make it bring forth and bud that it may give seed to the sower and bread to the eater, so shall God’s Word be that goes forth from my mouth. It shall not return to me void, but it shall accomplish what He pleases (desires, likes), and it shall prosper where He sends it. For I shall go out with joy and be led out with peace [completeness in spirit, soul, and body].

Jeremiah 17:14 - Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved, for I give all of my praise to You! [Thank You for healing me!]

Jeremiah 30:17 - God said He will restore me to health and heal my wounds.

Jeremiah 33:6 - Behold, God will bring health and healing, and He will cure me and will reveal to me the abundance of peace and truth.

Zephaniah 3:17 – The Lord my God is with me. He is a Mighty One, a Savior Who saves and heals. He will rejoice over me with joy. He will quiet me with His love. He will rejoice over me with singing.

Malachi 4:2 - But to those who fear His name, the Sun (window) of righteousness will arise with healing in His wings. I will go out leaping like calves from the stall.

NEW TESTAMENT

Matthew 6:10 – Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven [there is no sickness or disease in heaven].

Matthew 6:14-15 – I indeed forgive people of their trespasses [their reckless and willful sins, leaving them, letting them go, and giving up resentment], and my heavenly Father indeed forgives me. In fact, my Father forgives me my trespasses before I forgive the trespasses of others. [Forgiveness is a commandment. It is not an emotion or a feeling but is a decision. It is not based on someone else deserving forgiveness any more than I deserve forgiveness. This does not mean I must trust the person. They may need to earn my trust. I choose to live in instant forgiveness.]

Matthew 8:1-3 - When Jesus came down from the mountainside, large crowds followed him. A man with leprosy came and worshipped him and said, “Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean.” Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. “I am willing,” he said. “Be clean!” Immediately the man was cleansed of his leprosy. [God is no respecter of persons (Acts 10:34). What God does for one person He will do for all!]

Matthew 9:20-22 – A woman who was diseased with an issue of blood for twelve years approached Jesus from behind and touched the hem of His garment. She said to herself, “If only I may touch His garment, I shall be made whole (well).” Jesus turned around, and when He saw her, He said, “Daughter, be of good cheer, your faith has made you whole (well).” And the woman was healed at that very hour.

Matthew 9:27-30 – As Jesus left the house, two blind men followed Him, crying out and saying, “Son of David, have mercy on us!” Jesus said to them, “Do you believe that I am able to do this?” They said to Him, “Yes, Lord!” He then touched their eyes and said, “According to your faith let it be to you.” [I am becoming what I believe!]

Matthew 9:35 - Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness among the people. [By Jesus’ stripes, I am healed!]

Matthew 10:1 – When He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease. [As a child of God, I have the power to cast out all kinds of sickness and disease!]

Matthew 10:8 – Jesus commanded the disciples to go out into the world to, “Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.” [This same commandment applies to me!]

Matthew 11:12 – “From the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent (energetic) take it by force.” [I will work diligently with all of my ability and full faith in God’s Word to take my healing!]

Matthew 11:28 – “Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.” [I will give all of my problems to Jesus and He will give me rest.]

Matthew 12:36-37 - Every idle (useless, lazy, barren) word I speak [with no legitimate work, is inoperative, morally useless, and unprofitable], I shall give account of it at the day of judgment, for by my words I shall be justified (innocent, righteous), and by my words shall I be condemned (pronounced guilty). [I thank God for repentance and the blood of Jesus!]

Matthew 16:19 – God has given me the keys of the kingdom of heaven. Whatever I bind [forbid to be done] on earth shall be bound [forbidden] in heaven, and whatever I lose (destroy) on earth, shall be loosed (destroyed) in heaven. [Sickness does not exist in heaven, so in Jesus’ name, I destroy it {name the specific condition} in my body!]

Matthew 18:18-20 – “Verily (Surely), I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose (destroy) on earth will be loosed (destroyed) in heaven. Again, I say to you that if two of you shall agree on earth concerning anything they ask (beg, call for, crave, desire, require), it will be done (become, be brought to pass, be fulfilled, happen, be performed) for them by my Father in heaven. For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.”

Mark 9:23 – Jesus said, “If you can believe (have faith, trust), all things are possible.” [Jesus, I believe I am healed!]

Mark 11:23-24 – “For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain [or says to their sickness], ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart, but believes (has faith, trust in) those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. Therefore I say to you, whatever things you desire (ask) when you pray, believe (imagine) that you receive (accept, take) them, and you will have them.”

Mark 16:17-18 – Jesus said, “These signs will follow them who believe. In my name will they cast out devils (demonic beings). They will speak with new tongues [heavenly prayer language communicating directly to and secretly with God]. They shall take up serpents (an artful malicious person, especially satan), and if they drink any deadly thing, it will not hurt them. They shall lay hands on the sick and they shall recover.”

Luke 4:18 – The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because He anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor. He sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance (freedom, forgiveness, liberty) to the captives, recover sight for the blind, and to set free those who are bruised (crushed).

Luke 6:19 - All the people tried to touch Jesus because miraculous power was coming from Him and *healing them all*. [That same miraculous power and healing belong to me!]

Luke 10:19 – Jesus gave me the authority over all the power of the enemy, and nothing will by any means harm me.

Luke 18:1 – I should always pray and not be weary or lose heart.

John 10:10 – The thief comes only to steal, kill, and destroy [sickness and disease are stealing, killing, and destroying]. Jesus came that I might have life (health), and have it in abundance (exceedingly, beyond measure).

John 14:12 – Jesus said if I believe (have faith, commit to, trust) in Him, I will be able to do the works (acts, deeds) that He did, and I will do even greater things than Jesus did because of my faith.

John 14:27 – Jesus told me, “Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.” [I am holding on to Jesus’ promises to me!]

John 16:23-24 – Jesus said, “Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My Name He will give you.” I will ask and I will receive so that my joy (gladness, delight) may be full and complete.

John 20:29 – “Jesus said, ‘Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed.’” [I am blessed because I believe before I see!]

Acts 10:38 - God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, and He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him. [Because I have given my life to God, I am anointed with the Holy Spirit and power. I do good by healing all who are oppressed by the devil, for God is with me.]

Romans 4:17 - God gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist [complete healing, restoration] as though they do.

Romans 5:3-4 - We rejoice in our tribulations (afflictions, anguish, burdens, persecutions, and troubles), knowing that tribulation produces patience, and patience produces trust and experience, and trust and experience produce hope (faith). [I trust that God is working all things together for my good.]

Romans 8:11 – The Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in me. He who raised Jesus from the dead will also give life (healing) to my mortal body by His Spirit that dwells in me.

Romans 10:17 - My faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God. [When I hear myself speaking God’s Word, my faith grows and I become a God-pleaser.]

Romans 12:19 – Jesus said, “Dearly beloved, avenge (retaliate, punish) not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.” [I will never take revenge on those who have wronged me. I leave that to God. He will repay any wrong.]

1 Corinthians 13:4-8 – “Charity (affection, benevolence, love) suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth (boasts) not itself, is not puffed up, doth not behave itself unseemly (unbecoming), seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil; rejoiceth not in iniquity (injustice), but rejoiceth in the truth; beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things. Charity never faileth: but whether there be prophecies (predictions), they shall fail; whether there be tongues (language), they shall cease; whether there

be knowledge, it shall vanish away.” [I am loving, patient, and kind. I am not jealous, boastful, proud, or rude. I do not demand my own way. I am not irritable, and I keep no record of being wronged. I do not rejoice about injustice but I rejoice whenever the truth wins out. I never give up, never lose faith. I am always hopeful, and I endure through every circumstance. I will strive to not fail because God is in me!]

II Corinthians 1:20 – For all the promises of God are Yes and Amen (so be it) to bring glory to God from us.

II Corinthians 4:13 – I have the same spirit of faith (moral conviction, reliance upon Christ for salvation), according to what is written. I believed (have faith in, trust), and therefore I spoke. I also believe and therefore speak (tell, preach).

II Corinthians 5:21 – God made Jesus, who knew no sin, to be sin for me, that I might become the righteousness (equity of character) of God in Him.

II Corinthians 12:9 – When Paul was struck by an infirmity, he asked God three times to remove it from him. Paul recorded God’s response in this verse. “My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.” Paul responded that he would “most gladly, therefore, rather glory (boast, rejoice) in my infirmities (sickness, disease, weakness), that the power (force, miraculous power, ability, meaning, strength, mighty work) of Christ may rest upon (abide with) me.”

Galatians 6:9 – “Let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.” [I will not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time, I will reap a harvest of blessing if I don’t give up.]

Ephesians 2:8 – For by grace I am saved (healed, made whole) through faith. It is not from myself; it is the gift of God.

Ephesians 3:20 – Now to Him who is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that I ask or think, according to the power (miracle, strength, mighty work) that works in me.

Philippians 2:9-10 - God has highly exalted (raised to the highest position) Jesus and given Him the name which is above every name. That at the name of Jesus, every knee shall bow, of things in heaven, things in the earth, and things under the earth. [My disease has a name. I speak to that spirit of infirmity in Jesus’ name, and it must leave. I will not give up through unbelief or weariness because I do not want it to stay or return.]

Philippians 4:6-7 – I will not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication (petition, request) with thanksgiving I will let my requests

be made known to God. And the peace of God, which is higher than all understanding, will guard my heart and my mind in Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:8 - Whatever is true, whatever is honest (honorable), whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is of good report (reputable), if there be any virtue (praise, excellence), and if there be any praise, think on these things. [I will praise and think about only things which are honest, just, pure, lovely, good, and praise-worthy, in accordance with God's Word.]

Philippians 4:19 - My God will supply all my needs according to the riches (abundance, valuable bestowment) in glory (honour, praise, worship) by Christ Jesus. [God will supply everything I need to live on this earth, and I will continue to praise and worship Him.]

II Timothy 1:7 – For God has not given me a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

Hebrews 6:12 – “That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.” [Through faith and patience I inherit God's promises.]

Hebrews 11:1 – Now faith is the substance (assurance) of things I hope for, and is the evidence (proof) of things I do not see. [My faith perceives as real fact that which is not revealed to my natural senses. I believe I am healed even though I cannot see it with my natural eyes.]

Hebrews 11:6 - Without faith it is impossible to please God, for He who comes to God must believe Who He is, and that He is a rewarder of them who diligently seek Him.

James 1:2-4,12 – I consider it all joy when I fall into various temptations. I know that the trying of my faith brings out patience (endurance). I let patience do a perfect (complete) work in me, so that I may be perfect and entire (complete, perfectly sound in body, whole), wanting nothing. I am blessed (happy, fortunate) when I endure temptation, for when I am tried (approved), I will receive the victor's crown of life which God has promised to me because I love Him.

James 2:17-18 - My faith by itself if it does not have works (corresponding actions), is dead. I will show you my faith by my works (corresponding actions).

James 4:7 – I submit myself to God. I resist (stand firm against, withstand) the devil, and he will flee from me.

James 5:14-16 – “Is anyone among you sick? Let them call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him (or her), anointing him (or her) with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise

him (or her) up. And if he (or her) has committed sins, he (or she) will be forgiven. Confess your faults (sins, offences, trespasses) to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent (active, mighty) prayer of a righteous man avails much.”

I Peter 2:24 - Jesus bore my sins in His body on the tree, that I might die to sin and live to righteousness. By Jesus' stripes I am healed!

I Peter 3:9 – I do not repay evil for evil. I do not retaliate with slander or insults when people slander or insult me. Instead, I pay them back with a blessing. That is what God has called me to do, and He will bless me for it.

II Peter 1:3-4 – As His divine power has given to me all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who has called me to glory (honour, praise, worship) and virtue. [I know this because He has given to me exceedingly great and precious promises so that I can participate in the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in this world through lust.]

I John 1:9 – If I confess my sins, God is faithful and just to forgive my sins and to cleanse me from all unrighteousness.

I John 3:8 – He that committed sin is of the devil; for the devil sinned from the beginning. For this purpose, the Son of God was manifested (appeared) that He might destroy the works of the devil. [I can destroy sickness by commanding it to leave in Jesus' name.]

I John 3:23 – This is God's commandment, namely, that I should believe (have faith in, entrust, commit to) on the name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, as He commanded us.

I John 4:4 - He who is in me (Jesus/Holy Spirit) is greater than he who is in the world.

I John 4:17-19 – Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment because as He is, so are we in this world. There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear: because fear hath torment. He that fears is not made perfect in love. We love Him because He first loved us. [As God is, so am I in this world. There is no fear in love, but perfect (mature) love casts out fear. He who fears has not been made perfect (mature) in love. The love of God trumps fear.]

I John 5:14-15 – Now this is the confidence that I have in Him, that if I ask anything according to His Will, He hears me. And if I know that He hears me, whatever I ask, I know that I have the petitions that I have asked of Him. [Sickness and disease are not His will for any of us.]

III John 1:2 – “Beloved, I wish above all things that you may prosper and be in health, even as your soul prospers.”

Revelation 12:11 - I overcome the devil [and his fruit of sickness and disease] by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of my testimony. [Every time I take communion, I disable the hold of sickness progressively more and more.]

Revelation 21:4 – God will wipe away every tear from my eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away.
