Key points:

- When you're born again, you become a child of the most High God. He is the source of the greatest power.
- We don't just speak words of love, we act. Therefore, we have confidence that whatever we ask, He hears us.
- God wants us to forgive other because if we don't, satan can blind our eyes and steal our blessings. Forgiveness is a decision, not a feeling.
- God forgives us because He is unconditional love.
- We lay our life down by getting rid of pride and selfishness, forgiving others, and showing ourselves friendly.

Scriptures:

- Acts chapter 3 — story of the lame man at the temple gate healed by the power of God because he expected to receive something.
- 1 John 3:18 — My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth.
- John 14:6 — Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- 1 John 3:19 — And hereby we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before Him.
- 1 John 3:20 — For if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things.
- 1 John 3:21 — Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God.
- 2 Corinthians 4:4 — In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.
- 1 John 1:9 — If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- John 14:12-14 — Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If ye shall ask any thing in My name, I will do it.
- Mark 11:24 — Therefore I say unto you, what things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them
- Mark 11:25 — And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.
- Mark 11:26 — But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.
- John 15:13 — Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.
- 1 Peter 5:6 — Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time.

- James 4:10 — Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He shall lift you up.
- James 1:19 — Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath.
- Proverbs 18:24 — A man that hath friends must shew himself friendly: and there is a friend that sticketh closer than a brother.
- 2 Corinthians 9:10 — Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness.
