

God's Promises Are For You!

God wants every single person to be blessed in every area of their life. God has provided for us all our needs and desires. We simply need to learn:

- That God has already given us all things that pertain to life and Godliness.
- We must learn that it is God's will to have these things.
- We must learn how to receive what God has already given us.

It is very important to first make sure a person does not have any sins in their life.

- Psalm 139:22 teaches us to ask God to reveal to us if we have anything in our life that would hinder us from receiving from Him.
- If we do have sin, we are to simply receive God's forgiveness:
 - I John 1:9 -- If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- God has already forgiven us, but we must receive His forgiveness.
- Sin will blind our eyes from receiving from God:
 - II Corinthians 4:4 -- In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

Keeping this simple so that a little child can understand and receive:

- We must know God has already given everything we need.
- We must know that God's promises for everyone is "YES".
- We must accept and receive God's Promise.

Let's now examine in detail:

God has already given:

- II Peter 1:3 -- According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:
- Romans 8:32 -- He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?

All of God's promises are yes!

- Matthew 7:7 -- **Ask**, and it shall be **given** you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you.
 - **Ask** (Strong's g0154 aiteō) means crave, desire, and require.
 - **Given** (Strong's g1325 didōmi) means supply, furnish.
- I Corinthians 1:20 -- For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God **by us**.

- **By** (Strong's g1223 dia) means the channel of an act.

We must receive:

- Mark 11:24 -- Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, **believe** that ye **receive** them, and ye shall have them.
 - **Believe** (Strong's g4100 pisteuo) means imagine.
 - **Believe** (1828 Webster's Dictionary) means conceive.
 - **Receive** (Strong's g2983 lambanō) means literally (without exaggeration) to get hold of; accept, to experience.
 - "If there is conception of a seed, there is a receiving, accepting of a seed and all of God's Word's are God's seed".
 - I Peter 1:23 -- Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.
- Mathew 11:12 -- And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth **violence**, and the **violent** take it by force.
 - **Violence** (Strong's g0971 biazō) means to force, literally (without exaggeration) the means of good, life, that by which life is sustained, resources, wealth, goods.
 - **Violence** (root word – Strong's g0979 bio) means literally, without exaggeration, the present state of existence.
 - **Violent** (Strong's g0973 biastēs) means a forcer, an energetic strong force.
 - Keep in mind that Jesus was asked how to pray in Matthew 6:9-10:
 - Matthew 6:9-10 -- After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, **as it is in heaven**.
 - In Heaven, there is no sickness, diseases or problems.
 - A few chapters later; Jesus went into more detail of how to pray:
 - Matthew 11:12 – And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force:
 - This is how Matthew 11:12 reads in the original language of the Bible: And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven is experienced on earth when people energetically forcefully with their mind, spirit and physical actions, act like God's Word is true (this is a **VITAL ACTIVITY**).
 - * **Vital** (Webster Dictionary) means something that is necessary to a thing's continued existence.
 - * **Vital** (Webster Dictionary) means something that is necessary to a thing's continued existence.
 - * Anything that is vital is something that has to be; such as air, it is vital; we cannot live without it.

Please get happy and thankful that God has NOW given you all things that pertain to this life and Godliness. Please never get happier with the natural than the spiritual, and you will always enjoy life and see nothing but good days.

- Romans 8:6 -- For to be carnally minded is death; BUT to be spiritually minded is **LIFE** and peace.
 - In the original language of the Bible the word “Lived” is “Zoe” which has the meaning of having life the way God has it.
