

Visiting People in the Spirit, Part 3

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IMAGINATION IS THE DOORWAY INTO THE SUPERNATURAL

Imagination is a major doctrine of the bible!

- When we *imagine* God's Word as truth, we are using our mind's eye, our spiritual eyes.
 - *Imagine* (Strong's g4100 pisteuo) means the same as imagination.
 - The Greek word for imagination is rendered 220 times in the New Testament.
 - *Faith, believe, think, meditate* and *imagine* are co-equal terms in the Bible.

Imagination is the channel for having:

- II Corinthians 4:17-18 -- For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us *a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory*; While we look not at the things which are *seen*, but at the things which are not *seen*: for the things which are *seen* are temporal; but the things which are not *seen* are eternal.
 - *Seen* (Strong's g0991. Blepō) means to know by experience, to see with the mind's eye, to discern mentally.
 - This Greek word for *seen* is clearly referring to the imagination.
 - According to this passage if you are *seeing* the unseen, you are *seeing* with your minds eye, your imagination.
- With scriptures already given and more in this lesson, you see that *we use our minds eye, which is our imagination and without exaggeration, we can travel to the very house of God, to heaven. We can travel where we need to go to destroy things against God's purpose and establish things for God to be glorified and for people to be blessed.*
 - False religions have used truths for evil. We can use it for good. Just like some people have been given talent with a voice to sing, which is a gift from God, and they use it to glorify the devil.
 - People are afraid to use some of God's gifts because false religions have used them. However, take money for example. Money is used to further God's glory, but many people also use it for evil.

Pastor Marrels Moore:

Pastor Moore: a Lakota Indian Chief on the Rosebud Indian reservation back in about 1985 told me the story of a medicine man that would leave his body to go to people's homes to put curses on them.

- How much more should we, as children of God, leave our bodies with our spirit and travel to a place to stop bad things and establish the influence of God!

Our spiritual eyes are our imagination. Imagination is a major doctrine of the Bible. There are at least 285 verses in the N.T. where in the original language it is talking about imagination, such as Mark 9:23 and Mark 11:24.

- Mark 9:23 -- Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.
- Mark 11:24 -- Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

Without exaggeration, children of God can travel to God's house, they can go any place in existence with their spirits.

I've given several scriptures to validate these truths in the first two lessons, so now I want to go into more details concerning using our imagination to travel.

Importance of searching:

- John 5:39 -- Search the scriptures; for in them ye **think** ye have eternal **life**: and they are those who testify of me.
 - **Think** (Strong's g1380 dokeō) is rendered in the New Testament 62 times.
 - **Think** (1828 Webster's Dictionary & today's Webster's Dictionary) means to imagine.
 - **Life** (Strong's g2222 zōē) means literally absolute *fullness of life*.
 - *Fullness of life* is intended by God, even in this world, for those who put their trust in Christ.
 - EXAMPLE: In 1969, at Fort Riley, Kansas, I imagined I could lift my 1966 Mustang that weighed 2,600 lbs. over my head. And I did!

The ordination of meditation:

- I Timothy 4:15 -- **Meditate** upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all.
 - **Meditate** (Strong's g3191 meletaō) means imagine.
 - This Greek word is used 3 times in the New Testament.
